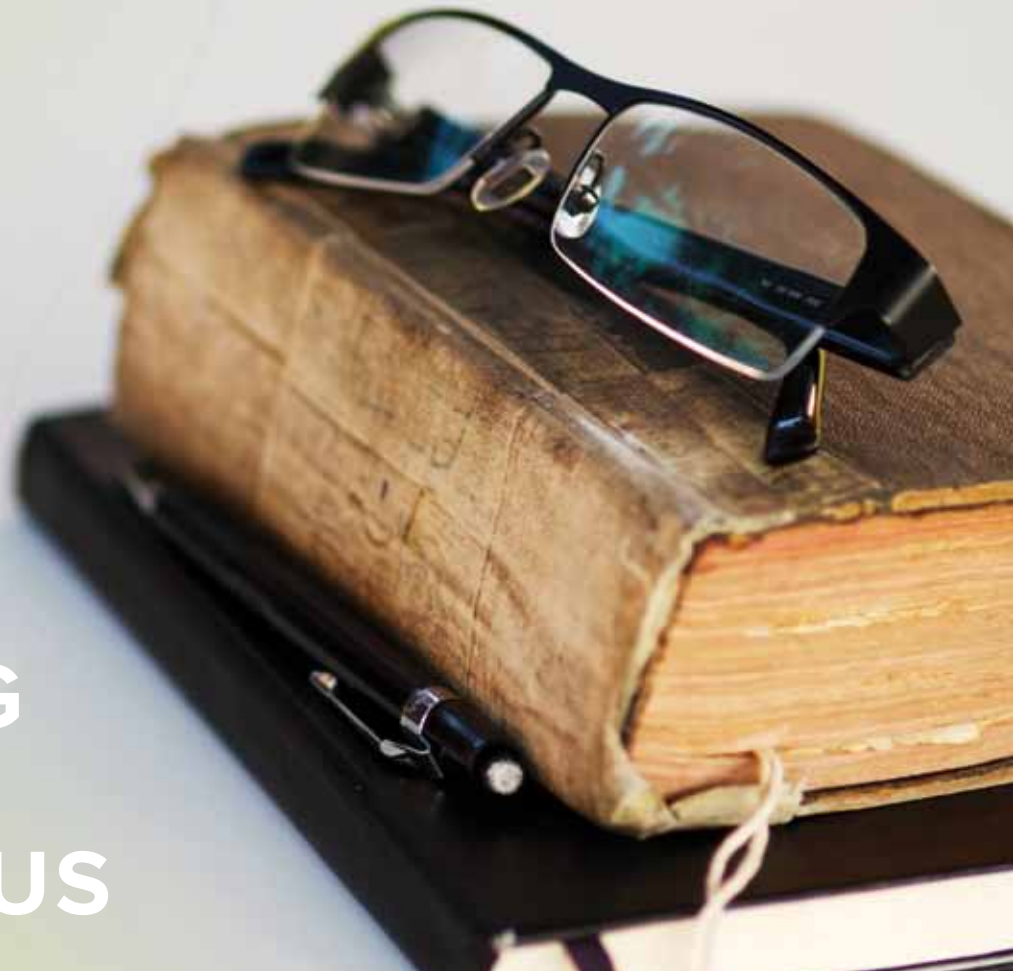

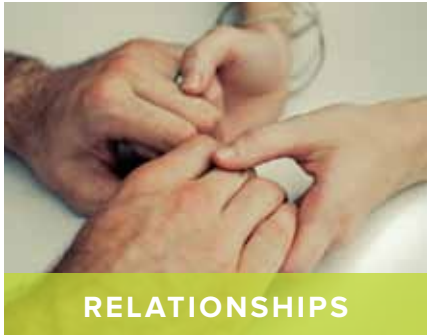
AT SYCAMORE VIEW, we realize mission statements can become the rallying cry for churches. Though these statements aren't essential to be a church that follows Christ, they can be helpful in uniting believers around a central, Godly purpose. Our mission is simple—*helping people see Jesus*. In the gospel of Luke, we read about a man named Zaccheus who climbs a sycamore tree to see Jesus speak to a crowd of people. As a result of hearing the message of Jesus, his life was forever changed. The significance of God's mission for our church is clear. As a family of believers, we are called to live out the gospel in an effort to give the world a better view of Jesus.



SINCE OUR MISSION IS TO HELP PEOPLE SEE JESUS, we are passionately convicted that reorienting people to Him is the only way to truly restore *hearts, relationships, and communities*. Our vision for the Sycamore View family calls for partnership with God to help restore the brokenness both in Memphis and around the world. We believe that restoration isn't a destination. Instead, it's the relentless pursuit of returning to life as God intended. As we partner with God to restore brokenness, we must be purposeful not only in determining *where* we are headed with His vision, but in knowing *how* we plan to get there. As disciples who have been restored, we seek to restore deeper relationships with God and our surrounding communities.



It is no coincidence that the two greatest commands involve matters of the *heart*. Loving God with all our heart and learning to love neighbors as ourselves are not easy tasks, but they offer the keys to restoring a broken world. Compassion for others includes not only a restored sense of love for God and others but also a renewed vision of humanity. Our capacity to give and receive love as Jesus did is the sign of a restored heart.



Before his death, Jesus prayed that all believers would be *relationally* unified just as He, the Spirit, and God are unified. From experience, we know that relationships have the power to hurt and the power to heal. By following Jesus' example of unity, we learn to restore relationships through compassion, forgiveness, reconciliation, planned connection, and healthy communication.



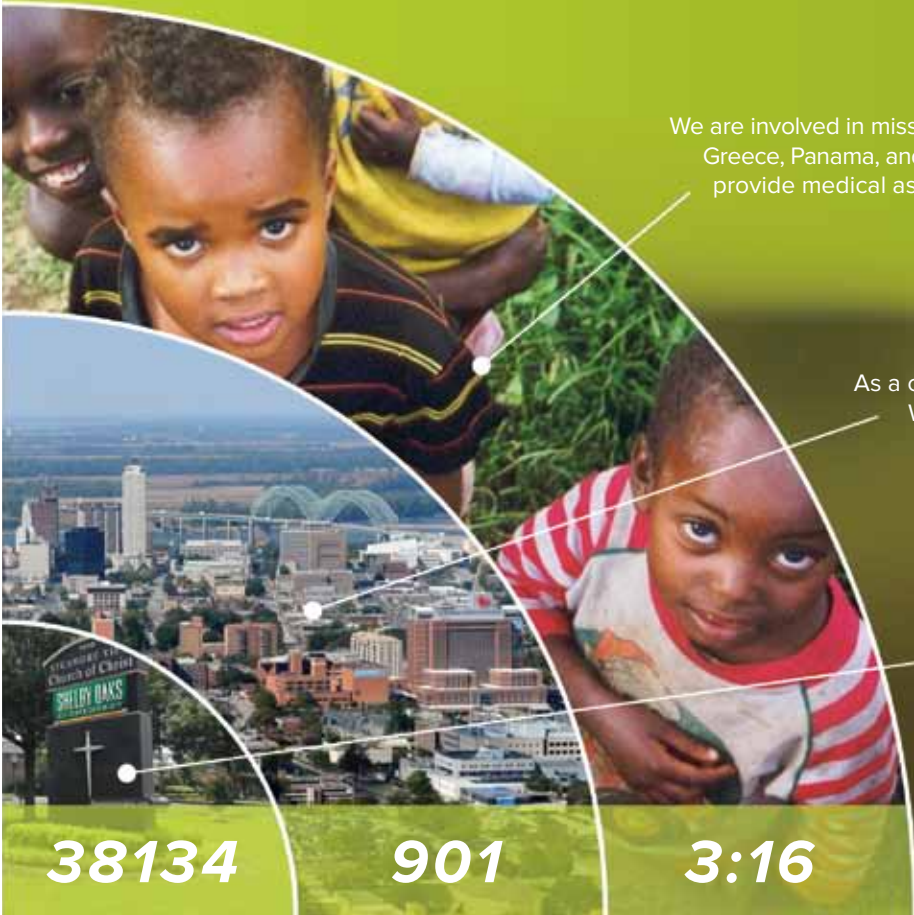

GROWING DISCIPLES

CHRISTIAN DISCIPLESHIP IS A LIFELONG JOURNEY of obedience to Christ that spiritually transforms a person's values and behavior. Zaccheus also models the journey of discipleship when he climbs a sycamore tree to *discover* Jesus. He later *connects* with Jesus, *serving* Him at his home. As a result of this encounter with Christ, Zaccheus eventually *gives* his possessions to the poor. At Sycamore View, our plan for helping you develop into a faithful disciple of Jesus is to cultivate a thriving environment that will help you mature and grow. In order for us to fulfill our commitment to you, we ask that every member carry out the **FIVE COMMITMENTS** below:



DISCOVER

Discovery is at the heart of our faith. This adventure involves searching for truth, pursuing Jesus, and discovering your role in God's Kingdom. We ask that you do the following:

- 1) Be present for our weekly worship together.
- 2) Prepare for a discipleship journey; not a destination.



CONNECT

God created us for community. We believe it's essential that everyone be engaged in a genuine connection to God and people through at least one of the following:

- 1) Sunday or Wednesday Bible Class
- 2) Life Group
- 3) Discipleship Group
- 4) Bible Study Group



SERVE

Jesus' desire is to create a church culture where service becomes a lifestyle. Because serving others helps restore hearts, relationships, and communities, we ask that every member commit to at least one of the following Ministry Teams:

- 1) Connect Team (Body Life, Adult Ed., Life Groups, Discover)
- 2) Serve Team (Local, Urban, Global, Compassion)
- 3) Give Team (Financial, Facilities, Hospitality)



GIVE

It's our belief that all things belong to God. We give of our time, talents, and finances because we have been given the greatest gift—Jesus.

- 1) Give during our weekly offering or online
- 2) Give to our 901 (Local Missions) and our 316 (Global Missions) offerings.



GO
